

PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

We are aware of the responsibility that comes with you entrusting us with your personal data, and therefore we protect your data in an appropriate manner. We have implemented technical, organizational and operational measures aimed at ensuring the security of your data and protecting it from loss or misuse.

Personal data are defined as data relating to an identified or identifiable natural person, who is a person who can be identified directly or indirectly. This means that data such as your name, surname, email address or telephone number belong under the term of personal data.

WHAT PERSONAL DATA DOES INmetric.in WEBSITE PROCESS AND FOR WHAT PURPOSE?

inmetric.in website processes your personal data only to the extent that you have provided us with. We obtain personal data like name and surname, e-mail address and telephone number via our contact form, in case you decide to fill it in. We always process your personal data in accordance with the purpose and legal basis we have communicated to you.

Whenever the processing of your personal data is based on your consent, your consent is voluntary and you can withdraw it at any time. Withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of the processing of your personal data before its withdrawal. Unfortunately, we will not be able to provide you with any of our services for which we need your personal data without your consent. For more information on how to revoke consent, see the "What are your rights" section below.

We will keep your personal data for the duration of your use of our services. We will delete your personal data after we cease to provide you with our services, unless the applicable generally binding legal regulations oblige us to process and / or store your data for a longer period of time. If you request the deletion of your personal data or withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data and we are not obliged under the applicable regulations to process and / or store the data, we will delete them within 30 days of your request.

WHAT ARE YOUR RIGHTS?

Pursuant to Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of personal data and Act no. 18/2018 Coll. on the protection of personal data, you have the right that will help you control the use and processing your personal data. You have the right to be informed about which personal data concerning you are processed, for what purpose, on what legal basis, to whom your data is made available. All this information will be provided to you free of charge, usually within 30 days from the date of your request.

You have the right to correct or delete your inaccurate, incomplete or outdated personal data. If your processing of personal data is not in accordance with the applicable law, or if the personal data

already processed is incomplete or inaccurate, you can request the correction, deletion or blocking of personal data. You may also object to the processing of your personal data due to your special situation and for serious legitimate reasons. You always have the right to object to the processing of your personal data if it is processed for direct marketing purposes. You have the right to obtain personal data that we process about you on the basis of your consent and / or contract and are processed by automated means, in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format. You also have the right to transfer this data to another operator. If technically possible, we will transfer your personal data directly to the operator of your choice at your request.

If you have already claimed your right, we will notify third parties if possible. We will fulfill your request unless we are forced to process your personal data in accordance with our legal obligations, usually within 30 days of your request.

To claim your rights, simply send us an email requesting it.

In case of our disagreement with your request, you can file a complaint with the Office for Personal Data Protection of the Slovak Republic, using the contact details published here.
